Maestro Santaella, through his years as a teacher and artist, is a prolific creator of the flamenco dance. Each class will focus on teaching his unique choreography that is inspirationally challenging and will allow students to expand their movement vocabulary. Emphasis and guidance will be given to each student on how to bring the fire and passion of the dance to their bodies and soul. Maestro Santaella is known for his signature contratiempos (counter rhythms) that bring life and fire to all his work. Classes can be taken individually or as a series. Combinations will be reviewed but will build from class to class.

Antonio Santaella is a native of Valderrubio, a small town in Granada, Spain. He started learning flamenco as a child from the gypsies of Sacromonte de Granada, focusing in particular on their style and arms. Critics have described Santaella's footwork as "exceptional," and his dancing as one with "an intensity, virtuosity and sound effect in away I have never seen." Noted flamenco figures such as Omayra Amaya have started their flamenco careers with Santaella.

As a young man, Santaella trained intensively with Rayito and Antonio Marin. Early in his career, he performed with numerous dance companies in Spain, particularly in Jerez, including El Principe Gitano and the companies of Pepe Moto, Roberto Iglesias and Rafael Aguilar. It was during his three years with Rafael Aguilar that he began to flourish as a choreographer.

Santaella currently teaches flamenco in Puerto Rico and is regularly invited for workshops and master classes around the world. In March 1999, he was invited to perform "Sombrero de Tres Picos" with the Symphony Orchestra of San Antonio, Texas. He has appeared in numerous television programs and films, and is frequently requested to choreograph for television and other special events throughout Puerto Rico.
